

The angel said, "Do not be afraid, For I bring you good news today. A Savior has been born to you, In the city of Bethlehem."


The shepherds went to Bethlehem, And found the baby Jesus lying in a manger. They worshiped him and gave him gifts, And then they returned home, rejoicing.

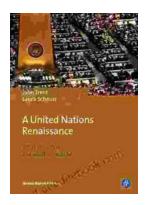
