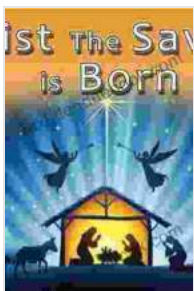

Savior has been born to you, In the city of Bethlehem."

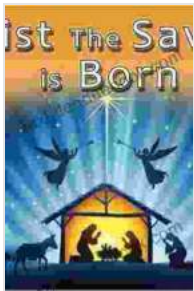
The shepherds went to Bethlehem, And found the baby Jesus lying in a

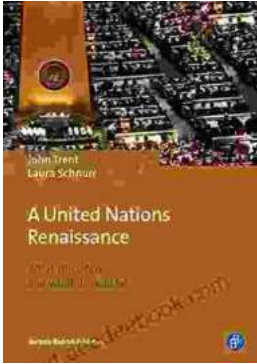
