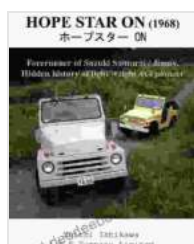


Hope Star: An Inspiring Story of Triumph Over Adversity - The Extraordinary Life of Yuichi Ishikawa
