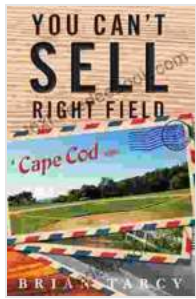


Six Minutes Early: A Haunting and Evocative Film by Brian Tarcy

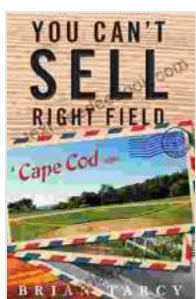
